Review meeting on HIVO's project has been conducted by Smt. Afzar, from CSA. The PC and other field staff of the project attended this meeting.

15.07.08

The PC NPM along with two HIVO's Co-ordinators have attended the one day work shop, Tarnaka, Secunderabad under HIVO's programme on the fallowing agenda items.

The methodology for following this cotton seed programme was explained in detail.

Vegetable fields, they were well explained about remedial measures by training them for preparation of the following liquid medicines.

- i. Jeevamruthram
- ii. Neemasthram
- iii. Green chillies' Garlic and inguva liquids.
- iv. Preparation of liquid with cow dung and its urine.

02/09

During this month the field coordinators of HIVO's project have motivated the farmers for SRI cultivation and also vegetable cultivations in the concerned villages of the project. In padira village of yellareddipet Mandal, one Shri.Gullapally Narayana Reddy s/o Bal Reddy has cultivated Hybrid paddy seeds of PHB.71 in an area of 20 gunatas for this Rabi season. He was given technical advice with regard to usage of weeds for removal of weed in the field besides sensitising him in preparation of "Neemasthram" to eradicate stem disease in the field. At present the field is in healthy conditions and the farmer is happy for the same.

The said farmer was sensitized and advised for usage of cow dung as manure for this field so that crop be comes strong with good number of tillers for high yielding.

Further, the farmers of all the 05 villages of the project, who have raised other Hybrid varieties like IR 64 MTU 1010 and pioneer Hybrid seed of PHB.71, were given technical guidance for preparation of "Neemasthram" and "Jeevamrutham" etc to strengthen their fields and also to protect their fields from various diseases

CEO visited Pothyreddypet village of Yellareddypet Mandal along with concerned field coordinator Shri. M. Dasharatham and seen the fields of pioneer paddy and also Vegetable seeds grown by different farmers of the villages and interacted with them, and ascertained about the status of the crops. Shri M.Dashartham field coordinator who was present with the CEO was instructed to render necessary technical assistance for eradication of pests and diseases likely to affect the paddy fields of pioneer's seeds and to take all precautionary steps for prevention.
